


Site Description	This is a fine rath, owned by the National Trust. It is a prominent landmark, with good views to Binevenagh & hills surrounding the Roe valley. The rath consists of a large central area, 38m N-S x 34.5m E-W, surrounded by a 2 banks with a ditch in between. The inner bank is 5.5m wide, 1.2m high internally and 3.5m over the ditch which in turn is 7m wide and 2.2m below an outer bank 3.1m wide and 1.7m high. An entrance to the rath at E is marked by a gap in the banks and causeway 5m wide over the ditch.
