Site Description	<p>Detached five-bay single-storey thatched cottage with hipped roof, with extension to rear. Hipped thatched roof with painted nap rendered chimneys, flat roof to extension to rear. Painted nap render to frontage, whitewashed rubble stone to rear with low buttress. Timber sash windows with painted nap render surrounds, timber panelled half-glazed door with painted nap rendered surround, small fixed timber windows to rear. Cast-iron fireplace, canted ceiling. Detached corrugated iron and timber clad outhouses to south. Owner says it has not been thatched in 14 years (visited in 1996).</p>
