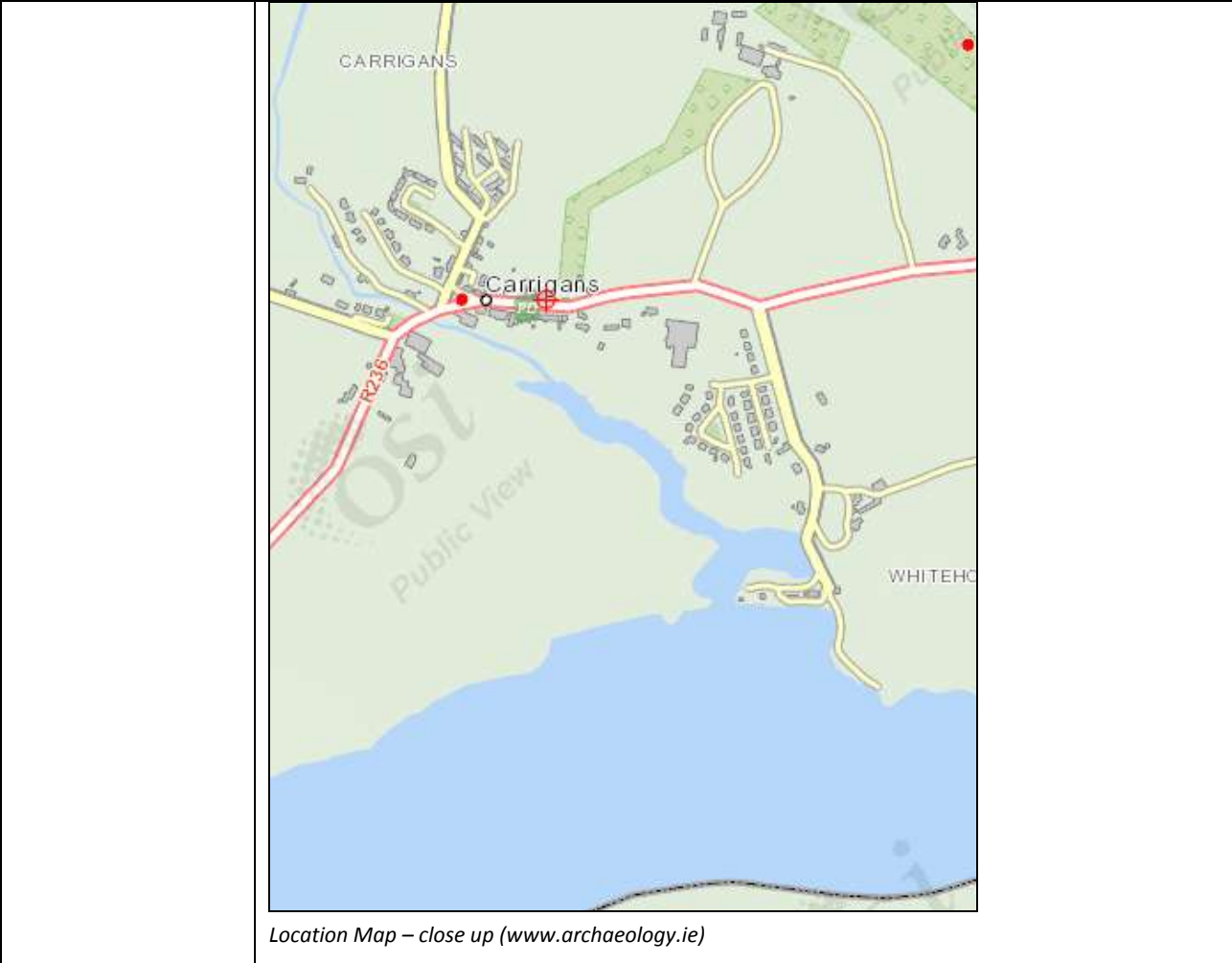

Site Description	<p>End-of-terrace three-bay single-storey house built c. 1890, with attic, facade enriched, c. 1930. Double pitched purple slates with exposed rafter ends at eaves, cast iron gutter and nap rendered chimney, red clay ridge tiles. Painted lined and ruled nap render with articulated, nap render parallel quoins. Timber sash windows with raised painted lugged nap render surrounds, timber panelled door with oval inset glazed panel, c. 1955. One of a terrace of four.</p>	
Landscape Context (setting)	<p>Located at the eastern end of Carrigans Town, south of the R236 road, overlooking the River Foyle to the south</p>	
Site Appraisal	<p>The site contains substantial remains and is easily accessible; however it is a private residence. It has the appearance of having been heavily modified in recent years.</p>

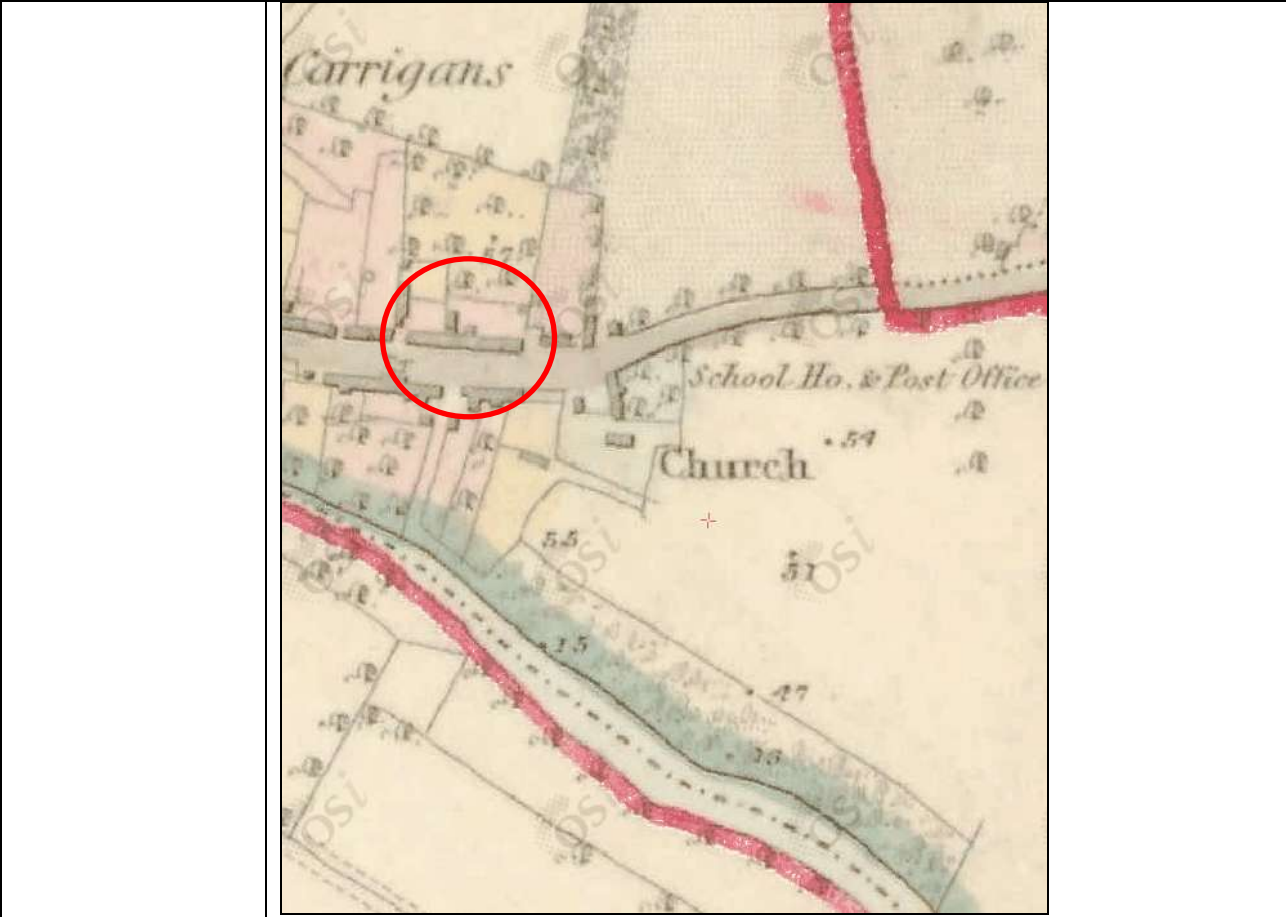
