<b>Site Description</b>	<p>Detached five-bay single-storey Church of Ireland church with projecting entrance porch to south-east, spire over chancel to north-east and vestry to northern corner, built 1858. Double pitch purple slate with Ashlar gable copings, skew blocks and dentils to eaves, dramatic octagonal Ashlar spire rising from broached rubble stone base. Squared snecked rubble limestone with diagonal buttresses with Ashlar feathered skews and quoins and battered base. Crown glass in lead quarries in pairs of Ashlar-dressed lancet-arched openings, with stained glass and weatherglazing to south-east, timber matchboard studded double doors with decorative wrought iron hinges in double-chamfered Ashlar lancet-arched opening. Graveyard to rear with memorial stones, stone steps up to entrance, rubble drystone retaining wall to front boundary with castellated copings and wooden double gates with stipple-rendered piers with Ashlar copings. M includes early glass, lead quarries, natural slate, decorative wrought iron hinges, etc</p>	
<b>Landscape Context (setting)</b>	Located on Bath Terrace, south of R238 road on the eastern side of Movice town

<b>Sensitivity</b>	This site is not very sensitive to damage, although it is still in use.	
<b>Associations</b>	Close to Church of St. Pius X (NIAH 40902208) and St. Colmcilles Holy well (DG022-007)
