Site Description	<p>Detached two-bay single-storey former vestry to former mid 19th century Presbyterian church now demolished, graveyard surrounding with memorial stones. Double pitch, purple slate with nap rendered chimney and gable copings and cast iron rainwater goods, projecting stone eaves course. Wet dashed rubble stone. Boarded up, rubble stone relieving arch over timber lintel to former opening to former church interior, now blocked up with rubble stone. Graveyard surrounding with memorial stones, steel gates between nap render piers. Church was built in 1827; vestry remaining appears to have been an extension.</p>	
Landscape Context (setting)	Located approximately 3km northeast of Redcastle, 6km southwest of Merville, to the northwest of the R238 road and overlooking Lough Foyle.
